Cottage Grove Community Participant Information

Participant Profile Statistics

- **Total Participants and Demographics**
- Cottage Grove has facilitated Circles for 31 participants (some of which are organizations).
- One-third (35%) of participants are female (61% male).
- Two-thirds (65%) of participants are Caucasian/White, 13% Black/African American, and 6% Asian.
- Almost one in five (16%) participants were known to be veterans.

- **Participants Completing the Circle Process**
- Of the participants who have finished the circle process, 65% have successfully completed.
- On average, length of time in Circle, for participants who successfully completed, is 1 year and four months, with an average of 23 separate circles.
- On average, for each participant who successfully completed, there were 190 volunteer hours devoted per case.



Community Profile

Active for over a decade

The Cottage Grove community has been actively accepting cases since 1998. The Cottage Grove community has participated in sentencing, healing, support, and conflict resolution circles.

Types of Cases

The Cottage Grove Community takes many types of cases. Over seven in ten (71%) cases are Sentencing Circle cases, 13% support, 10% healing, and 3% other types of cases.

Close Ties to Tubman

WCCC, and the Cottage Grove community have a close relationship. About two-thirds (65%) of Cottage Grove's cases were referred by Tubman. Also, 65% of the Cottage Grove community's Circles are Domestic Abuses cases.

Focused on the Victims

Where applicable, victims participated in almost two-thirds (64%) of cases.
