Woodbury Community Participant Information

Participant Profile Statistics

- **Total Participants and Demographics**
- Woodbury has facilitated Circles for 16 client participants over five years.
- Seven in ten (69%) of client participants are male (31% female).
- Eight in ten participants (81%) are Caucasian (29% Asian and Black/African American)
- The average age for participants is 34. Participants' ages range from 18 to 55.
- One third (31%) of participants were known to be veterans.

- **Participants Completing the Circle Process**
- Of the participants who have finished the circle process, two thirds (67%) have successfully completed.
- On average, the length of time in Circle, for sentencing circle participants, is one year and three months, with an average of 13 circles. The average for participants who successfully completed is one and a half years with an average of 16 separate circles.



Community Profile

Active for over five years

The Woodbury community has been actively accepting cases since 2006. The Woodbury community has participated in sentencing circles from the Courts and Tubman.

Types of Cases

Three fourths (75%) of the Woodbury Community cases are domestic abuse cases.

Dedicated Volunteers

On average, for each participant who successfully completed a sentencing circle, there were 130 volunteer hours devoted per case. For all completed cases (successful and unsuccessful), the average hours were 110 per case. For all completed cases, an average of 5 volunteers participated on each case.

Including Victims in the Process

In completed sentencing circles, victims attended circles in one third (33%) of cases. In two-thirds (67%) of the completed cases, victims attended at least one circle.
